Ironically, however, the more inclusive and universalist Masonic ideas became, the more threatening its members' economic and emotional bonds

The dissertation concludes by presenting teacher formation structures and strategies for introducing Lasallian operative commitments and by providing a Lasallian Mission and Vision Statement.
